

Submissions invited for Youth Forum Logo Design Competition

The following is issued on behalf of the Commission on Youth:

Members of the public, especially young people, are invited to take part in a Logo Design Competition organised by the Commission on Youth (COY).

A COY spokesman said today (April 29) that the competition aimed to promote the COY Youth Forum to the general public.

“The COY, in conjunction with the Home Affairs Bureau, is organising district-based youth forums to provide a platform for young people to participate in public affairs through the process of deliberating on policy issues and conveying their views to the Government and the wider community. It is hoped that young people can enhance their understanding of the forum through participation in the competition,” the spokesman said.

The competition is divided into Youth and Adult Groups. Winners of the competition will receive cash awards, certificates of merit and gifts. Participants can either submit their design online (website: www.youthforum.hk) or by post (Sing Tao Publishing, 2/F, Tower B, Sing Tao Building, 1 Wang Kwong Road, Kowloon Bay, Kowloon).

To encourage wider participation, there is also a special award chosen by the public, “My Favourite Youth Forum Logo Design”. Members of the public can select their favourite logo design through online voting from June 1-12, 2005. Those who vote will have the chance to win cash prizes.

Application forms are now available at the website. People can also obtain application forms at District Offices’ Public Enquiry Service Centres. The deadline for submission is May 23, 2005. Results will be announced on the website on June 19, 2005.
