

SHA congratulates HK athletes on winning five medals in EAG

The Secretary for Home Affairs, Mr Tsang Tak-sing, conveyed his congratulations to Hong Kong athletes who won two gold, one silver and two bronze medals in the East Asian Games today (December 9).

"Hong Kong athletes have achieved remarkable results in squash, swimming and badminton events. We are all very proud of them," Mr Tsang said.
