

SHA congratulates HK athletes on capturing ten more EAG medals

The Secretary for Home Affairs, Mr Tsang Tak-sing, congratulated Hong Kong athletes on winning one gold, two silver and seven bronze medals in the East Asian Games today (December 11).

"I am thrilled by the excellent performance of our athletes who have won a total of ten medals today at the games. We are deeply impressed by their exemplary participation and sportsmanship," Mr Tsang said.

The Hong Kong delegation has so far won 11 gold, 18 silver and 33 bronze medals in the 2009 EAG.
