
The Home Affairs Bureau today (April 30) announced the re-appointment of Prof John Leong Chi-yan as Chairman of the Public Libraries Advisory Committee (PLAC). The appointment of three new members and re-appointment of 11 serving non-official members were also announced.

The advisory committee is appointed for a two-year term, effective from May 1, 2010, to April 30, 2012.

The advisory committee advises the Government on the development of public libraries in Hong Kong, including the formulation of strategies and measures for the development of library facilities and services; the role, functions and management of the Hong Kong Central Library as well as the encouragement of community support and partnership with different sectors in promoting reading, lifelong learning and literary arts.
