

District Council Chairmen to visit Taiwan

To strengthen exchanges between people in Hong Kong and Taiwan, as well as enhance District Councils' knowledge of community facilities, and cultural, arts and sports developments in Taiwan, a delegation of District Council Chairmen will pay a four-day visit to Taiwan.

The District Council Chairmen's delegation will be in Taipei and Taichung between September 26 and 29 to visit a number of community, cultural, arts and sports facilities.

Tuen Mun District Council Chairman, Mr Lau Wong-fat, will be the head of the delegation, while the Secretary for Home Affairs, Mr Tsang Tak-sing, will join the visit in the capacity of Vice Chairperson of the Hong Kong-Taiwan Economic and Cultural Co-operation and Promotion Council.
